THE FORT WORTH TARRANT COUNTY BRANCH NAACP MOURNS THE PASSING OF NAACP LIFE MEMBER JUDGE L. CLIFFORD DAVIS

Fort Worth, TX (2/16/2025) - It is with great sadness that the Fort Worth Tarrant County Branch NAACP join our city, county, state and nation in mourning the passing of a Civil Rights legend, Judge L. Clifford Davis.

Judge Davis was an active Life Member of the NAACP who believed in fighting for the civil rights of others in education, housing, employment and public accommodations. It was his work in education that had a lasting impact on the Tarrant County community. His work as an NAACP lawyer to help desegregate both the Mansfield & Fort Worth Independent School Districts was significant. He was a man of integrity that was faithful to one guiding principle: To treat all people with decency, courtesy, dignity and respect without regard to that person's race, their color, culture, education, age, sexual orientation, religion or non-religious experience, political affiliation, economic status, or any other socio-economic factor. He believed it was everyone's civil responsibility to do the same.

May we remember his charge to all of us to stand up for the civil rights of others and to always be willing to be a beacon of change.
